The Project is to be substantially complete by April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and finally complete by May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

The Work to be performed includes constructing four "minor" stormwater improvements throughout the City.

Bids shall be a combination of lump sum and unit prices per the Bid Form.

Bidding Documents are on file electronically at the office of the Engineer and may also be examined at the office of the Owner at the address listed above.

Copies of the Bidding Documents for use in preparing Bids may be obtained electronically from the office of the Engineer (Clear Water Solutions) by requesting to be placed on the Plan Holders List in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. A MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE WILL BE HELD AT THE CITY OF FORT LUPTON OFFICES AT 130 S. MCKINLEY AVENUE AT 2:00 P.M. LOCAL TIME, FEBRUARY 19, 2010. Bids from bidders not listed as attending the mandatory pre-bid conference will remain unopened. Bidders are also required to provide evidence of recent and extensive experience in constructing pipelines in the local area. Bids from bidders not meeting the minimum criteria established by the City will be rejected.

Each Bidder shall file with his Bid a Bid security in the amount of 5% of bid price in the form of a cashier's check, certified check or a bidder's bond in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The Bidder to whom a Contract is awarded will be required to furnish a Performance Bond guaranteeing faithful performance and a Labor and Material Payment Bond guaranteeing payment of all debts arising out of the Work.

No Bid may be withdrawn for the period of time after the date Bids are opened which is specified in the Bid Form.

Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, and to waive any informalities or irregularities therein.
